WHO SHOULD ATTEND: Teacher leaders, ESL specialists/consultants and administrators

This session is designed to support teacher leaders, ESL specialists/consultants and administrators to facilitate learning opportunities for teachers about the use of the Alberta K-12 English Language Proficiency Benchmarks. This workshop will provide a facilitator guide to assist leaders in facilitating the workshop: "Understanding and Using the Alberta K-12 English Language Proficiency Benchmarks" with classroom teachers who have English language learners. You will learn how to facilitate a workshop based on The Alberta K-12 English Language Proficiency Benchmarks. This resource is an assessment tool that will assist teachers to identify English language proficiency level, monitor language development, set appropriate language goals and communicate with parents. The workshop materials include interactive content specific to the ESL Benchmarks theoretical framework; BICS and CALP and Communicative Competence and working with the ESL Benchmarks in Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing. The ESL Benchmarks are organized by division; K, Grades 1 -3, 4-6, 7-9, and 10-12.
